1. Complete Your NHSRA Membership

Go to <https://nhsra.equestevent.com>

- Returning members: Use your existing profile. Do NOT create a new account.
- New members: Create a new profile.
- Pay National, State, and Region membership fees online.
- Print, sign, notarize, and upload the Membership Application and Minor Release forms.
- Both parents (when applicable) and the contestant must sign all required documents.
- Ensure the notary includes every required name.

2. Region IV Membership Packet

Download the correct membership packet from thsra4.com.

- Junior High members must use the JH packet.
- High School members must use the HS packet.

3. Required Documents

NEW MEMBERS: Upload Birth Certificate, W-9, Final Report Card, Photo Release, Social Media Release, Membership Application, and Minor Release.

RETURNING MEMBERS: Upload Membership Application, Minor Release, and Final Report Card.

JH members moving to HS must also upload new Photo and Social Media Release forms.

4. Important Deadlines

- All membership documents must be uploaded by August 22, 2026.
- Membership must be approved before entering Rodeo #1 or #2.
- Entries for Rodeo 1&2 open on eQuest July 27, 2027

- Cutters and Reined Cow Horse contestants must also have completed memberships before competing. (Contact secretary for more information on dates/locations)

5. Additional Membership Requirements

- Sell at least 15 Ford Truck raffle tickets.
- Sell at least 4 Bloomer Trailer raffle tickets (Region IV requirement).
- Purchase/Sell a minimum \$50 State Program Ad.
- Purchase/Sell a minimum \$50 Region IV Program Ad.
- Submit Student Officer/Event nominations via email to THSRA4.com before the first rodeo.
- Paid Adult Members are eligible to vote on matters presented to the membership during rodeo season and vote on nominations/elections.
- Checks, other than rodeo entry checks, will be deposited as they are received.

6. Dress Code

Contestants must wear full western attire while in the coliseum (stands and arena):

- Cowboy hat
- Long-sleeve shirt tucked in
- Blue jeans
- Cowboy boots
- Back number (replacement numbers: \$5).

7. Communication

Region IV will use the SportsYou app instead of Remind. Please join SportsYou and follow the Region IV Facebook page for announcements.

8. Rodeo Entries

Rodeos 1 & 2: Enter and pay online through EQuest only and open July 27, 2027.

After Rodeo 2:

- Continue entering online through EQuest, **OR**
- Submit paper entries with payment at each rodeo. (If your payment is not left with the entry form, the only option will be to enter/pay through EQuest. No entries will be accepted without payment.)
- Entries will close Friday at midnight the week before the rodeo.
- Late entries are open only on EQuest until Sunday at midnight the week before the rodeo with a \$50 late fee. No phone entries will be accepted. (You must pay online)
- Entries paid by check will be deposited the Monday before the rodeo.
- Rodeo payout checks will be void after 90 days.
- Partner events require your partner's EQuest number to enter.

9. Slack

Slack remains available.

- \$100 individual
- \$150 family

Slack moves your Saturday run to Sunday. Saturday Slack runs will be run Sunday before each event.

10. Verify Your Entries

Check thsra4.com on Monday before each rodeo to verify your entries. Contact the secretary immediately if corrections are needed. Entries become final at 4:00 p.m. Wednesday before each rodeo. There will be no changes to entries after 4:00 p.m. Wednesday. No Exceptions.

- Review your checklist carefully
- Watch the website, Facebook Page, and SportsYou for updates
- Stay tuned for Breakaway & Team Roping Jackpot information
- See flyer for optional BIG MONEY Sidepot
- Membership documents must be complete and approved before you may enter a rodeo.

If you are a new member, start registration by clicking the New Member Signup dropdown menu. The registration form will be displayed. The Season is set to the current season. Registration is open for all states:

- Utah - Junior High School
- Wisconsin - High School
- Wisconsin - Junior High School

If a renewing member, District Secretary and/or State Secretary creates a new account for an existing member, it will be deleted and the member will have to go into their existing account to complete their registration. In addition, any documents uploaded into the new account will have to be uploaded into the existing account by the member.

As secretaries, you have access to all your members' profiles, which contains their usernames and email addresses.

Below are instructions on how members access their profiles, see below:

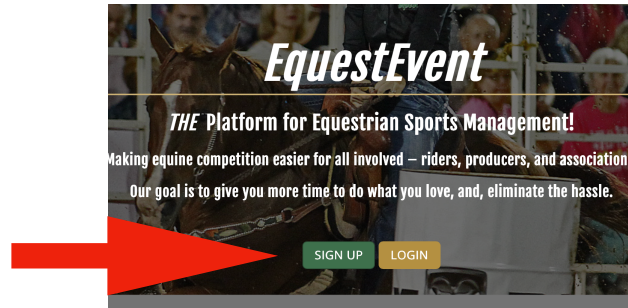

We are pleased to know that you are thinking about becoming a member in this great association where **"The Elite Compete"**. Along with the requirements of the region you are thinking about joining, there are a few the THSRA requires, and so there will be no misunderstanding as to what these requirements are, they are listed below:

1. You must be in good standing, under 20 years of age, and be considered a full-time student with passing grades in 70% of classes taken. Any student attending a **private, home-school, year-round school or correspondence school**, must show proof of full-time status (passing 70% of classes) and the grade report must be a professional, computer generated document with the signatures of the teacher(s) for each subject. Any of these types of schools must be a state accredited school/program. If there are any questions, you must get pre-approved **ONE (1) MONTH PRIOR TO DEADLINES** through the THSRA State Office by calling **936-590-4447**. All students, even the ones in public school, will be required to turn in a report card or transcript with their membership application, at mid-term and at the State Finals. Any questionable documents of public, private, home, year-round or correspondence school received at deadline times will result in ineligibility of points for a minimum of two (2) rodeos, until the problem is worked out. **Any documents that are falsified will result in immediate disqualification from the association.**
2. You will be required to sell **fifteen (15) Truck Raffle tickets** by December 2026 and have these returned to your region secretary. For every five (5) tickets sold, you will receive one (1) free ticket.
3. You will required to sell the designated number of **\$50 Bloomer Trailer Raffle tickets** that your region requires by December 2026 and have this returned to your region secretary. High school members will receive one (1) free ticket with membership and one (1) free ticket for every three (3) tickets sold.
4. You will also be required to sell at least **one (1) \$50 State Ad** for the THSRA State Finals program. For any additional ads sold, the member will receive 25% commission on the additional ad amount and your region will receive 20% commission once the total sales has reached \$350.00.

THSRA members selling the most total ads and sponsorships will receive the following awards:

- **National Sponsors Advertising:** All NHSRA National Sponsors can have any type of garment, vest, hat, tack or helmet advertising in any size, including stick-on, sew-on or embroidered patches.
- **Non- National Sponsor Advertising in the arena and at awards presentation areas:**
 - Non-sponsor advertising may not be larger than a 2.5"X3.5" area. This includes garments, hats, protective vests, helmets and tack. There will be no stick-on or sew-on patches for non-national sponsor advertising.
 - Garments, protective vests, hats: advertising must be fully embroidered into the fabric (**not** a sewn-on patch).
 - Advertising on tack must be permanently carved or pressed into the item and meet the same size requirements. A saddle may have a larger sponsor area but must be pressed or carved into the area. A saddle pad may have the standard branding on the wear leather.
 - Protective helmets: no non-sponsor advertising on helmets.
 - No more than one non-sponsor embroidered area per garment per sponsor.

If you are sponsored and have a question concerning if it is permissible to promote them in the arena at the NHSFR by including their name, logo and/or mark on any part of you or your horse, please feel free to call the NHSRA National Office at 303-452-0820 before you get to the NHSFR and ask for Chanel Haworth.
